

Severe Weather Evacuation Plan

Radio and television stations will broadcast the latest tornado advisory information:

KCLD (FM) St. Cloud 104.7

KNSI (AM) St. Cloud 1450

WW JO (FM) St. Cloud 98.0

KKCM (AM) Waite Park 1390

When a tornado approaches, your immediate action may mean life or death. ***Do not stay in your mobile home during a tornado or severe weather storm.***

Seek inside shelter at the following location:

STORM SHELTER UNDER COMMUNITY BUILDING

The shelter will be open for community safety anytime South Haven is placed under a severe thunderstorm warning or tornado sirens sound.

In order to accommodate everyone in the shelters, management requests that all residents abide by the following rules:

- No alcoholic beverages permitted
- No animals permitted
- Parents are responsible for children's behavior

If an emergency occurs, and you cannot seek shelter, get out of your home and find a low area to take refuge. Do not stay in your home!

Whenever dialing 911, always request the "South Haven Fire and Rescue Department"

Fire

1. Call the Fire Department at 911 - Ask for South Haven Fire and Rescue, giving the name of the Park, Address of your home and site number and the location of the fire within the Park
2. Evacuate the area to at least 500 feet

Gas Line Break: TOP PRIORITY: Clear the Immediate Area!

1. Call Ferrellgas 763-682-2494 and or your propane provider.
2. Notify the Fire Department (if necessary) at 911 - ask for South Haven Fire and Rescue
3. Notify Community Manager at 320-274-8857

Total Electric Power Failure

1. Call Wright-Hennepin REA at (320) 963-5800
2. Notify Community Manager at (320) 274-8857

Water Main Break

1. Notify Community Manager at (320) 274-8857
